

Greens report February 2017

January and February so far have been productive months, with the green staff progressing well with the winter programme.

Greens have been cut and slitted at least once a week, this will increase as we progress into March.

All the tee boxes have been shockwaved and continue to be cut once a week. The par 3's have been sanded and seeded with the rest of the tee boxes being done before the season starts.

Fairways have had their first cut of the year, and have been slit to try and help with some "well needed aeration and drainage". We have also tried to cut some rough with the small rotary cutter. Hopefully as the ground dries out we shall be able to get the larger rough cutter out on the course during March.

Other work that has been carried out includes:

Edging paths

Staining the patio furniture

Cutting hedges around the car park and tee box areas.

Digging a drain at the back of the 3rd green to catch the spring water flowing onto the course.

Machine maintenance

There is now a letterbox up in the hallway towards the locker room, for all members to air their views on the course and to leave any suggestions on further improvement.
